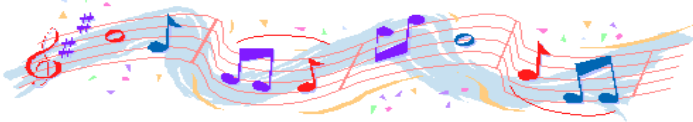

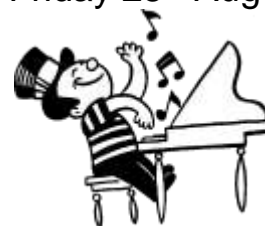
We regret to say that numbers are now deteriorating; please do your best to help support. ☺

Film Afternoon

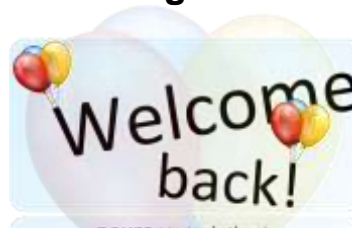

Active Minds items

The care home now has a basket of items situated in the library area of the main lounge, which is available to friends and family of residents in the care home to borrow to use with residents. These items are designed for people with dementia but are equally enjoyable to use with anyone, as they help interaction by giving an activity when sometimes conversation can be difficult. These items encourage quality time together. Items included are; aqua painting sheets, with brushes and tubs for the water. Jigsaws, starting with just 13 pieces having shapes of pieces set behind the jigsaw to make use easier. Memory cards to aid discussion and magnetic boards with various themes to them with magnets on them which can be used like fuzzy felts, to create pictures.

We ask that anyone borrowing these items signs them in and out and then logs the activity in the care plan folder situated with-in the resident's room. These items really do make a difference as they bring back memories and help enhance discussion.
